Over 1.9 million people are incarcerated in the U.S. Wardens and prison officials are advocating for Christ-centered rehabilitation programs to stop recidivism. Inmates who become committed Christians do not return to prison.

Additionally, UPMI's programs prepare inmates for reentry into societyphysically, mentally and spiritually.

In 2022, UPMI successfully delivered over 180,000 books (as shown above) to Cuba, collaborating with the Unión Cubana de los Adventistas del Séptimo Día (Cuban Union Conference of SDA) to ensure these books reached various locations across Cuba.

Looking ahead to 2025, UPMI is thrilled to share that it will once again provide the book, Respuestas A Preguntas Bíblicas (Bible Questions Answered), aiming to distributing over 70,000 transformative volumes to our brothers and sisters in Cuba. UPMI will collaborate once more with the Cuban Union Conference of SDA and Henry Stubbs from the World Youth Group to facilitate distribution of these books. Praise the Lord!

UPMI sends literature free of charge to prisoners both in the USA and Internationally.

OUR HISTORY

UPMI was established in 1981 by Richard and Carolyn Bland while they worked with more than 100 churches in Alabama's prison system. What began as a labor of love has blossomed into the distribution of over 78 million Bibles, Bible lessons, and transformative literature across the U.S. and around the globe!
